

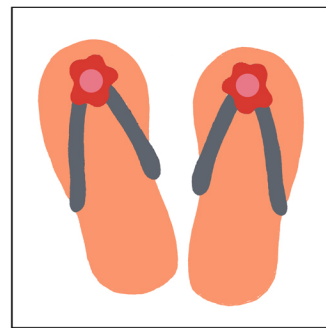
Flip flops are summer couture!

Summer Flip Floppin'

for the Splendid Sampler™

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"



Requirements

- # 7" square light colored background fabric
- # Fabric scraps for appliqued flip flops
- # Lightweight fusible web for machine applique (I recommend Heat n Bond Lite by Thermoweb)
- # Thread for machine applique (I recommend Aurifil Cotton 50 wt.)
- # 2- 3/8" buttons

Instructions

Trace applique shapes onto paper (non-adhesive) side of fusible web. Cut out the shapes, leaving about 1/8" border around each shape.

Following fusible web manufacturer's instructions, use an iron to fuse shapes to wrong sides of fabrics. Cut out shapes on line and peel off paper backing.

Arrange applique shapes on background fabric, following diagram on next page for placement. Iron in place. Machine applique using matching thread and your favorite applique stitch.

Sew buttons to flower centers.

Trim block to 6 1/2", centering the appliques.



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
