

## Requirements

Scraps of 22 different fabrics divided into 5 different colourways.


- # Fabric A: 8 squares 1 ½" x 1 ½", 1 each of different print in same colourway.
- Fabric B: 8 squares 1 ½" x 1 ½", 1 each of different print in same colourway.
- Fabric C 4 squares 1 ½" x 1 ½", 1 each of different print in same colour.
- # Fabric D 4 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- # Fabric E 4 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"


## **Block Assembly**

Press all seams open.


- 1. Sew a 4-patch using A and B 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares.
- 2. Make 4 A/B 4 -patch units.




- 3. Sew a 4-patch using C 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares.
- 4. Make 1 C 4-patch unit.



- 5. Sew a D and E 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together.
- 6. Make 4 D/E units.



- 7. Lay out units in rows. Sew units together to make a row.
- 8. Sew rows together.



9. Unfinished block size 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"s
