## Cutting \& Sewing

## Light Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3 " x 3 " for HST units
- Cut 4 rectangles 1.5 " $\times 2.5$ "
- Cut 1 square 2.5 " x 2.5 "

Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares $3 " \times 3$ " for HST units

Directions

1) Sew the dark and light 3 " squares Using HST method on next page.
Make 4 units


- Cut 4 rectangles 1.5 " $\times 2.5$ "

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## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

## NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"



Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares


Step 2

- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


## Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST


## Step 4

-Trim squares to $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
