## Bonus block for The Splendid Sampler by Pat Sloan



Block Light fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3.5 " x 3.5 "
- Cut 8 squares $1.5 " \times 1.5$ "

Block Medium fabric

- Cut 8 squares $1.5 " \times 1.5 "$

Block Dark fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5 "


## Square the Block to 6.5" x 6.5"

Finished size $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$

When I create blocks, I love to space to showcase lovely fabric. Having gorgeous fabric is why I quilt.
The beauty of a simple block lets us showcase.


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## Directions

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 1.5 " square Make 8

2) Following the diagram, place a light 1.5 " square on the corner of the dark 3.5 " square Sew on the line.
Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the square
Repeat for all 4 corners
Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam.
Make 2 blocks
Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

3) Repeat Step 2 with a medium 1.5" squares and light 3.5 " square Make 2 blocks
Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

4) Alternate the 4 blocks to make the center Make 1 block
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
